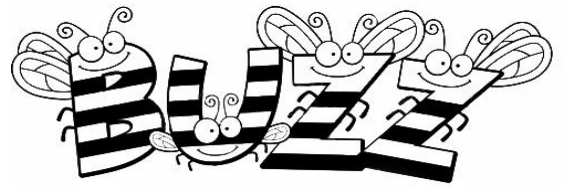




TX-802



The doors to Camp Curry 51 were opened at 7:00 pm and cadets that arrived headed to their appropriate barracks to place down their bags and then waited for the rest of the cadets to arrive. After all of the cadets showed up, our squadron commander Lt. Col Levesque had a safety briefing for the cadets. Afterwards the Flight Sergeants marched the cadets to the gym.



Different groups worked on drill and prepared for their drill test. The drill test is essential for cadets to get promoted, if they don't pass their drill test they won't get promoted, until a satisfactory score has been achieved on the test. At 10:00 pm cadets take showers, when they are done taking a shower the cadets proceed to the appropriate barracks and go to sleep at 10:30 pm. On Saturday morning cadets were awoken at 6:00 am, the cadets were marched down to the gym to do PT (physical training). Cadets are not able to promote if they don't pass their PT test. Right after



the PT test cadets went to take a refreshing shower. Once their personal time is up, they get changed and they start preparing themselves for the required assignments for their next promotion. Breakfast begins, customs and courtesies must be reinforced: they are a very

important part in Camp Curry because it shows the cadets respect to the NCO'S and officers.

Cadets will start their studying sessions for their test after breakfast; cadets



have to take two exams: an appropriate Aerospace and Leadership exam. Cadets have to pass quizzes and fill out their review to be eligible to take their written exam. After they have studied and completed all quizzes they must complete their aerospace exam. Lunch starts at 12:30pm!! After

lunch the groups adjusted and placed individuals in their next class for the Leadership education. With enough work and effort the cadets passed the exam with outstanding grades! Dinner time began at 6:00 pm! The cadets changed into their PT clothing in order to participate in "Fun PT Night" at 8:00 pm, where the cadets play dodge ball, sharks and mines and other fun activities. The activity ended at 9:45 pm, where they proceed to their personal time (showers, brushing teeth etc.) and went to bed at 10:30 pm. The next morning on Sunday, the cadets wake up and pack their bags at the front door. Then they proceed to clean the bathrooms and the areas that the cadets have studied in. The cadets packed up to leave as they called their parents, sign out and leave home.

Overall the majority of cadets passed and about 25 cadets or more will get promoted in the next promotion ceremony, this Thursday, 26 February 2015 @ 6:45 p.m.

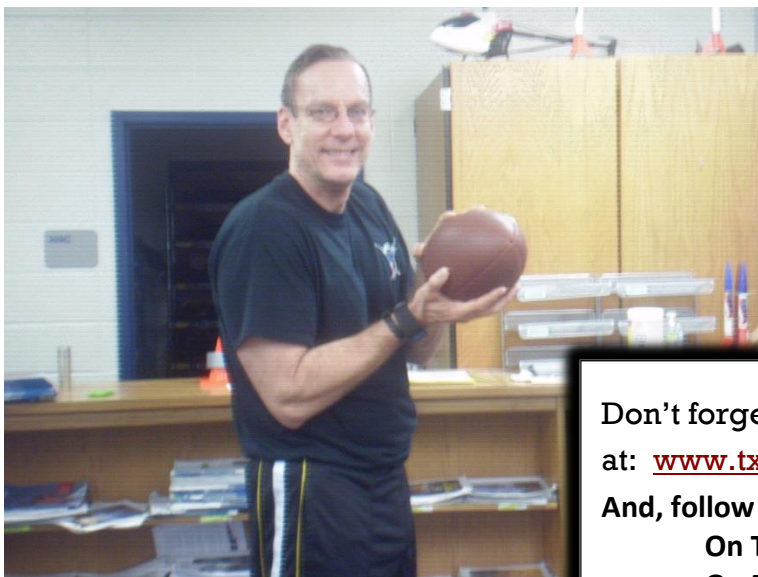

Commander's Corner

The Merit of Order List (MOL) that establishes rankings for cadets has begun to show its value with the selection of personnel to attend the Louisiana Wing Conference. The highest point total for males and females for 6th, 7th and 8th grade will be going to Pineville, LA 6-8 Mar. That same weekend we have six cadets attending CTEP and have at least one member in each of the four schools. Operation Seguin III will be 27-29 Mar and we are targeting approximately 32-36 cadets to attend. The MOL will draw cadets from CAP I, II and III as well and from KHS. We will continue to use this tool when we have a limited number of seats to attend activities. The updated version after Camp Curry 51 will be published for the promotion ceremony. We are working to add an ICUT or communications day class to get your CAP communications license for 11 Apr. More to follow later.

Unit activities are what make this unit strong. The following activities will give you a chance to experience new places, people and an opportunity to find out about CAP beyond the classroom.
